**Motion** by Delegate to suspend the rules in order to consider the petition of the RHOE-AA. Seconded by Delegate. No debate; **motion carries**.

**Motion** by WGA Greg Pelley to accept the RHOE-AA petition for affiliation. Seconded by Delegate. Discussion. Pelley explains the Grand Council is in receipt of a Petition for Affiliation from the Rhoecus Alumni Association, and all is in order to the satisfaction of the Grand Council. Call to question and seconded. Motion to accept the Petition for Affiliation from the Rhoecus Alumni Association: no debate; **motion passes unanimously**.

*Credentials committee states there are now 29 delegates seated.*

Normal order of business resumes.

Credentials Committee Report is accepted by Convention without dissent.

Worthy Grand Architect asks all those requesting special consideration from the delegates in good standing to seat a delegate to come forward.

**Motion** is made by RHOE-AA to seat by special consideration Rhoecus Chapter; seconded by DOMI.

Discussion. RHOE-AA reports that Rhoecus Chapter is in the process of being incorporated, payment of affiliation of \$3000, and settling payment of back dues. Discussion of the history of the Rhoecus Chapter: lack of previous alumni association, how they have an alumni association now and that the chapter can be rebuilt.

Called to question by Delegate, seconded by DOMI.

Motion to seat Rhoecus Chapter delegate:

$\frac{3}{4}$  vote required

14 yes, 10 no;  $\frac{3}{4}$  of 29 is 22 in favor: **motion fails**.

**Motion** is made and duly seconded to remove from the room all persons not initiated by Alpha Rho Chi for reading of Ritual report.

**So moved with no objections.**

**Motion** is made and duly seconded to not allow movement during reading of report.

**So moved with no objections.**

Ritual Committee Chair, Brother Brian Swilling, submits the report for the Ritual Committee. Read by Brother Swilling and Brother Christine Brazill in summary.

Discussion. Question regarding proposed Alumni Ritual.

**Motion** is made and duly seconded to accept report; **motion passes unanimously.**

## **Convention Secretary Announcements**

Convention Secretary notes that all requests for Secretary Announcements should be in writing.

Resolutions are due to the Convention Secretary by 7pm local time today.

**[Call to Order.]**

Convention Secretary takes Roll Call: 30 present.

The Convention President notes that the Convention agenda is running ahead of schedule! As such, it is recommended that the Convention move on to Unfinished Business and New Business motions that have already been distributed in the Convention registration packets. Accepted with no objections.

## **Unfinished Business**

Tabled motion regarding the collection of dues by National organization, to be disbursed to Chapters and Alumni Associations as collected.

Motion 57-04, requesting due diligence be done to determine if the national fraternity should collect Alumni dues for both national fraternity and local alumni associations. Motion was sent to Committee at the 57<sup>th</sup> National Convention. It was brought to the floor again by the 58<sup>th</sup> Convention, under Committee Reports. Per the Official Minutes of the 58<sup>th</sup> National Convention, motion was made, duly seconded, and passed to table Motion 57-04 until the 59<sup>th</sup> National Convention.

**Motion tabled** due to lack of second; to be debated as unfinished business at the 60<sup>th</sup> National Convention.

## **New Business**

### ***59-01 (split into a & b motions, see below)***

I move that Article IV, Section 02 of the Alpha Rho Chi By-laws be stricken, and Article V, Section 01 be amended to wit:

#### ARTICLE IV

#### CONVENTION DELEGATES

Section 01 Each Active Chapter shall have one (1) delegate who shall have one (1) vote. Each Alumni Association shall have one (1) Delegate who shall have one (1) vote.

Section 02 The Grand Council collectively at the Convention shall have one (1) vote.

A. The Grand Council Delegate shall be recused from voting during the election of Grand Council Officers.

**Motion** by ANDR to split motion into 2 separate motions: One to strike and other to amend.

**Motion** to amend article 2 by Brother Machado. Motion ruled out of order by Chair.

Motion to close debate and call the question by VITR; second by DAED-AA.

**Motion passes** by raised-hand vote: Motion is split as 59-01a and 59-01b.

### ***Motion 59-01a***

I move that Article IV, Section 02 of the Alpha Rho Chi By-laws be stricken such that Article IV reads:

#### ARTICLE IV

Convention Delegates

#### Section 01

Each Active chapter shall have (1) Delegate who shall have one (1) vote. Each Alumni Association shall have one (1) Delegate who shall have one (1) vote.

Discussion.

Motion is called to question and seconded; **motion passes** by majority declaration of Chair.

### ***Motion 59-01b***

I move that Article V, Section 01 of the Alpha Rho Chi By-laws be amended to wit:

#### ARTICLE V

Non-Delegates

#### Section 01

All Fraternity members are privileged to attend the Convention at all times, to take part in the debates, and to offer resolutions or motions, which, if seconded by a delegate **or a Grand Council officer**, shall be regarded as offered by a delegate.

Seconded by: Scott Strnad (ANTH-AA)

**Motion to table** by Cleisthenes Chapter; objections; **withdrawn** by maker with no objection.

Motion to call the question by Delegate; seconded by Delegate. Vote.

Motion fails to earn majority required to pass; **motion fails**.

### ***Motion 59-02***

I move that Article I of the Alpha Rho Chi Constitution be amended to wit:

#### ARTICLE I

NAME, EMBLEMS, MOTTO, AND AWARDS

#### Section 02 EMBLEMS

The emblems of the Fraternity shall consist of a badge, a coat-of-arms, a sister pin, a recognition button, a pledge button, a system of colors, and a flower.

Section 06 BADGE, COAT-OF-ARMS, ETC.

The official form of the badge, coat-of-arms and pledge button shall be as prescribed in the Ritual.

Brother Pelley speaks on behalf of the motion.

Main motion now does not mention Section 02 of Article I.

**Motion** is made and duly seconded to open the floor for discussion. **Motion passes** unanimously.

Discussion.

Motion is called to question by Delegate; seconded by Delegate. **Motion passes** by majority declaration of Chair.

### ***Motion 59-03***

I move that Article VI, Section 01 of the Alpha Rho Chi Constitution be amended to wit:

#### ARTICLE VI

#### THE GRAND COUNCIL: DIRECTORS AND OFFICERS

#### Section 01 THE DUTIES, ELECTION AND APPOINTMENT OF DIRECTORS

The Grand Council shall act as the Board of Directors for the Fraternity. It shall consist of the four (4) elected officers of the Fraternity and the Grand Advisor (G.A.) who shall be a past Grand Council member, **or a member of the Fraternity, having been initiated no less than 10 years prior to appointment**, and who shall be appointed every two (2) years by a majority vote of the four (4) elected members. The Grand Council shall have general jurisdiction, when the Fraternity is not meeting in Convention, over matters of administration pertaining to the Fraternity as is specified in, but not limited to, the By-Laws of the Fraternity, subject to such duties, limitations, or instructions specified by the membership at any Regular or Special Convention.

Brother Horton speaks on behalf of the motion. Further discussion.

Motion is called to question by Delegate and seconded by Delegate. **Motion passes** by majority declaration of Chair.

I move that Article XII, Duties of the Grand Advisor, Section 01 of the National By-laws of Alpha Rho Chi Fraternity be stricken. Section 02 shall then become Section 01, and Section 03 shall become Section 02.

Seconded by: Richard Jenkins (META)

Brother Horton speaks on behalf of the motion. Further discussion.

Motion is called to question by Delegate and seconded by Delegate. **Motion passes** by majority declaration of Chair.

**[Call to order at 2:05 pm]**

Convention Secretary takes roll call: 29 delegates present.

### ***Motion 59-05***

I move that Article IX, Section 01 (A) of the Alpha Rho Chi Constitution be amended to read:

ARTICLE IX  
INDIVIDUAL MEMBERSHIP  
Section 01 CLASSES OF MEMBERSHIP  
(A) Active Members  
**Active members shall consist of students registered in collegiate course in Architecture or the allied fields leading to a Bachelor's degree.** When an active member transfers to another school, at which a Chapter of this Fraternity is located, he may affiliate as an active member of the second Chapter with its approval.

Motion made by: Gregory S. Pelley, WGA  
Seconded by: Scott Strnad (ANTH-AA)

**Motion to amend** by META-AA to add “of the Alpha Rho Chi constitution” for clarification. Accepted without objection by maker of motion and second.

**Motion** for recognition of IKTI-AA Delegate before debate on motion begins. Discussion. So moved. *Thirty (30) delegates are now seated.*

Brother Pelley speaks on behalf of the motion. Motion is made and duly seconded to open the floor for discussion. Motion passes unanimously.

**Motion to table** by VITR-AA. Seconded by Delegate; **motion fails** to gain majority vote required.

Further discussion.

**Motion to amend** from Gallery to add specific list of majors. Seconded by DEME-AA.

Motion to amend main motion called to question by Delegate; seconded by Delegate. Vote fails to reach majority required; one abstention (CLEI). **Main motion is not amended.**

**Motion to amend** from Gallery to add: **“Individual chapters are open to further restrict how their chapter membership is constituted.”** Seconded by Delegate. Accepted without objection by maker of motion and second, but META-AA objects to motion to amend as worded. Motion to amend motion to amend main motion to change “further restrict” to “further define”; seconded by RABI-AA. No further objections. **Motion to amend motion to amend carries with no objections.** With no further objections or discussion, **motion to amend main motion carries** by majority declaration of Chair.

Main motion now adds “Individual chapters are open to further define how their chapter membership is constituted” at end of motion text.

**Motion to amend** from Gallery to strike “leading to a Bachelor's degree or equivalent.” Seconded by Delegate. Discussion. Motion to amend called to question and duly seconded. **Motion to amend fails** to gain majority vote required. **Main motion is not amended to strike.**

**Motion to refer** to committee by Delegate for further analysis; seconded by Delegate. No debate; **motion carries** by majority declaration of Chair.

**Motion 59-05 is referred to committee** to report findings 90 days before the 60th convention, made of no more than 10 members of the national fraternity including the maker of the main motion, to further define the motion at hand.

In evaluating a petition for affiliation, the Grand Council shall not categorically deny any petition solely on the basis of an academic institution not having an architecture program. The Grand Council shall examine the petition based on its merits, evaluate the academic institution in its entirety and determine the appropriateness of a new chapter at the specified location.
