



Alpha Rho Chi Fraternity Student Chapter and Colony Advisors Policy

December 2014

Each student chapter or colony of Alpha Rho Chi is required to be represented by an advisor of record at all times. Student chapters that fail to retain an advisor of record may be considered for suspension for denial of the authority of the Grand Council of the Fraternity. Colonies that fail to retain an advisor of record will be disbanded for denial of the authority of the Grand Council of the Fraternity.

This advisor must be a full-time member of the university staff and must be physically present on campus for the majority of the academic year during which he or she serves as the advisor of record. In addition, the advisor must be able to fulfill the university's requirements for advising student groups.

The advisor is responsible for reviewing, understanding, and complying with the information included in the document "Expectations for Alpha Rho Chi Student Chapter or Colony Advisors," which is located on the national website. The advisor must acknowledge that he or she has read and understands positional expectations and must provide current contact information to the Worthy Grand Architect no later than October 15th each calendar year. The contact information will be included for publication on the fraternity's Master Directory.
